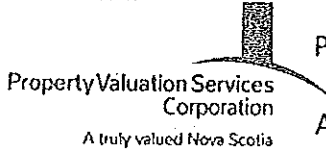

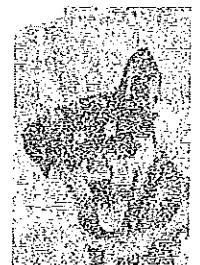

Get your 2014 Dog Tags ... they're Free

Please note the Council of the Municipality of the District of St. Mary's would like to remind residents that a recently approved motion to waive the dog registration fee was passed.

Please be advised that by law all dogs are required to be registered and must have a tag. Did you know that 95% of all lost dogs found with a license tag do get home! The license tag is identification that will assist the By-law Enforcement Officer in returning your dog should it ever become separated from you. The licensing year runs from January to December.

You may drop by the office in Sherbrooke to pick up your tag and to register your dog.

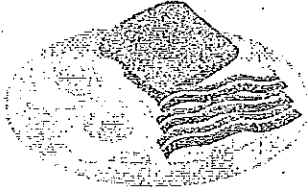

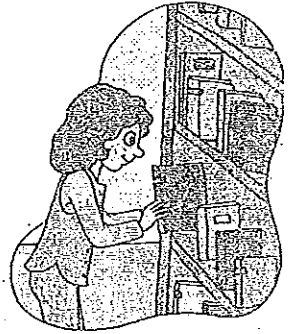
