4. Approval of the Agenda:

7. Correspondence

a. Department of Municipal Affairs & Housing 12 Month Notice Letter – Minister of Municipal Affairs & Housing, John Lohr

b. Saint Mary's River Association – Designation of Archibald's Lake as a Wilderness Area

- The St. Mary's River Association requested Council to send a letter to the Minister of Environment supporting the designation of Archibald's Lake as a Wilderness Area.
- Council discussed the potential of designating Archibald's Lake as a Wilderness Area.


