### **Position Summary:**

Working under the direction of the Active Living Coordinator, the Lifeguard will provide lifeguard services during swimming lessons held throughout the municipality.

### **Duties:**

- Overall safety of participants at swimming programs and/or other aquatics programming
- Participate in staff meetings and training sessions
- Ensuring lifesaving and teaching equipment is up to standard and maintained
- Oversee swimming programming at summer events
- Assist Recreation Staff at special events
- Liaison with facility staff during swimming programming
- Additional program leadership as assigned

### **Education Requirements:**

- National Lifeguard certification is required
- Water Safety Instruction certification would be considered an asset
- Successful applicant MUST be attending or returning to an educational institution in the Fall of 2020.
- High Five training would be considered an asset

### **Skills and special knowledge:**

- Must possess strong supervisory skills
- Must possess organizational and administrative skills and ability to multi-task.
- Must be able to work independently and as part of team

### **Additional Documentation:**

- Applicants must pass a Criminal Record check
- Applicants must pass a National Child Abuse Registry check
- Valid driver's license considered an asset
- The successful applicant is required to attend training workshops (no exceptions)
