General Labourer – Part time/Casual Position

The Municipality of the District of St. Mary's is seeking an individual for the position of **General Labourer – Part time/Casual**. Location of work will vary between the Municipal Transfer Station, 150 Cape Gegogan Rd and Municipal properties located within the Sherbrooke area. This position is classified as permanent part time/casual employment beginning early February 2024 and hours will vary from 7.5 to 15 hours bi-weekly year-round.

The General Labourer duties will include but are not limited to; efficient and safe operations at the Municipal Transfer Station, maintaining logs of incoming and outgoing waste, operating backhoe, performing general maintenance to municipal properties such as mowing, lawn care, snow removal, painting, trail clearing, etc. The position requires an individual that can work independently with minimal supervision.

A valid Nova Scotia Drivers' License is required. Basic math, reading and writing skills are required along with customer service skills. The pay rate for the position will be \$16.44/hr. plus vacation pay.
