



**Municipality of the District of St. Mary's**  
**Request for Quote – Roadside Brush Clearing**  
**Gegogan Road – Trunk 7 to Transfer Station**

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1. The Municipality of the District of St. Mary's is requesting a Lump Sum price for clearing brush from both sides of the Gegogan Road from trunk 7 to the entrance gate at the Transfer Station.
2. The Scope of work consists of clearing brush a distance of 3m from the shoulder of the road beginning at the intersection of trunk #7 and extending to the Entrance Gate of the Transfer Station, both sides of the road. Brush/trees are to be cut to a height not greater than 150 mm from the ground. The material is to be chipped/mulched and left evenly dispersed (no large piles) in the ditch. Gegogan Road is to be kept free from debris during the work and a final cleanup done following completion of the project.
3. The work site is to be clearly marked with appropriate signage and the roadway kept open for vehicle traffic during the brush clearing work. Proper traffic safety procedures are to be followed for the project.
4. The Municipality is requesting quotes from qualified contractors in our area for the completion of the work described in this request.
5. Submissions should include proof of \$2 million liability insurance and certification of Good Standing with the Nova Scotia Workers Compensation

Board. Also please provide a list of equipment proposed to be used for the project.

6. Quotes are to be Lump Sum prices for the job, excluding HST. The Lump Sum price is to include all costs for labor, equipment, and all other expenses.
7. 9. Project Timeline. Time is of the essence for this project. Work should be completed within three weeks of the award of the contract.
