



## TENDER – STUMPAGE

The Municipality of the District of St. Mary's intends to clear land to allow for future expansion of the Construction & Demolition (C&D) site at the Gegogan Transfer Station site at 150 Cape Gegogan Road.

Approximately 25 to 30 Acres of wood land is to be clear cut and the wood products removed for sale by the contractor. All non-marketable materials are to be felled but can remain on site.

Stumpage will be paid to the Municipality on a per Tonne basis for wood products harvested.

- Proof of contractor general commercial liability insurance in an amount of not less than \$2,000,000.00.
- Contractors are encouraged to visit the site to estimate volumes and site conditions prior to submitting bids.
- Work to be conducted in accordance with good Forestry standards (NS Forest Products Association) and to meet all Provincial regulations regarding forest harvesting, environmental controls and safety practices.
- Work is to begin no later than July 2, 2019 and is to be completed by August 31, 2019.
